



2010 Scholarship Program

As a locally based Telephone Cooperative, Marquette-Adams is committed to supporting the communities it serves. As part of that offering, Marquette-Adams will be funding scholarships to students planning to attend or are already attending a trade school or university. Our 2010 scholarship program will provide twelve scholarships at \$1000 each.

The scholarships will be available to high school or home schooled seniors planning to attend a university, technical school or trade school. Scholarships will also be available to students currently attending college, technical or trade schools. Specific criteria must be met in order to be considered for a scholarship. The requirements for high school seniors are as follows:

The high school senior or home schooled senior and/or their parents, guardians or foster parents must be a full-time resident, have telephone service with Marquette-Adams Telephone Cooperative or MAC Long Distance or maqs.net Internet service with Marquette-Adams.

The requirements for current college, technical or trade school students follow:

Students currently attending college, technical or trade school may apply for a scholarship as long as they are not a previous scholarship winner from Marquette-Adams and must meet the criteria mentioned in the above paragraph.

Scholarships must be filled out properly, typed via typewriter or word processor and returned by the deadline in order to be considered.

Scholarship deadline is March 8, 2010

The successful recipients' college, technical or trade school of choice will receive payment from Marquette-Adams Telephone after completing the first semester with at least a 2.0 GPA and after registering for the second semester. The check will be made out to the school, but sent to the scholarship winner.

To be eligible for a scholarship, the student and student's parents, foster parents or guardians must be a permanent resident of telephone dial tone with the Cooperative, an Internet subscriber with maqs.net and/or a long distance subscriber with Marquette Adams Communications. Your phone exchange must be 296, 297, 339, 564, 584, 586, 587, or 589. Certain restrictions may apply.

Scholarship Deadline is March 8, 2010

What is your first choice of college, trade or technical school?

The following four items need to be completed:

- 1:** List any academic distinctions or honors you have won in grade levels 9-12.
- 2:** Include a self-introduction in five or less lines.



3: Note any meaningful or volunteer activities in which you have been actively engaged and you feel are most meaningful to you. (Include years of participation, grade levels and any offices held.)

4: List three personal references, including one High School English Teacher. Please include one written recommendation.

Upon receiving your scholarship and to receive your scholarship money, you must have the proper information in our office no later than March 8, 2010. This information will be on the scholarship certificate provided by Marquette-Adams Telephone.

\$1000 Scholarship Essay

To be considered for this scholarship, all prior pages of the application must be completed, the proper criteria must be met and the following essay question must be answered.

***Type your Scholarship Essay on a sheet of its own.
The essay requires no less than 300 words.***

What have you done during your high school years to help plan for your advanced education and why do you feel it is important if you receive or do not receive a financial scholarship for your advanced education?

Include a tagline your Cooperative could use to show the benefits provided.
